## THE LOWER CHURCH OF THE CATHEDRAL OF OUR LADY FEODOROVSKAYA

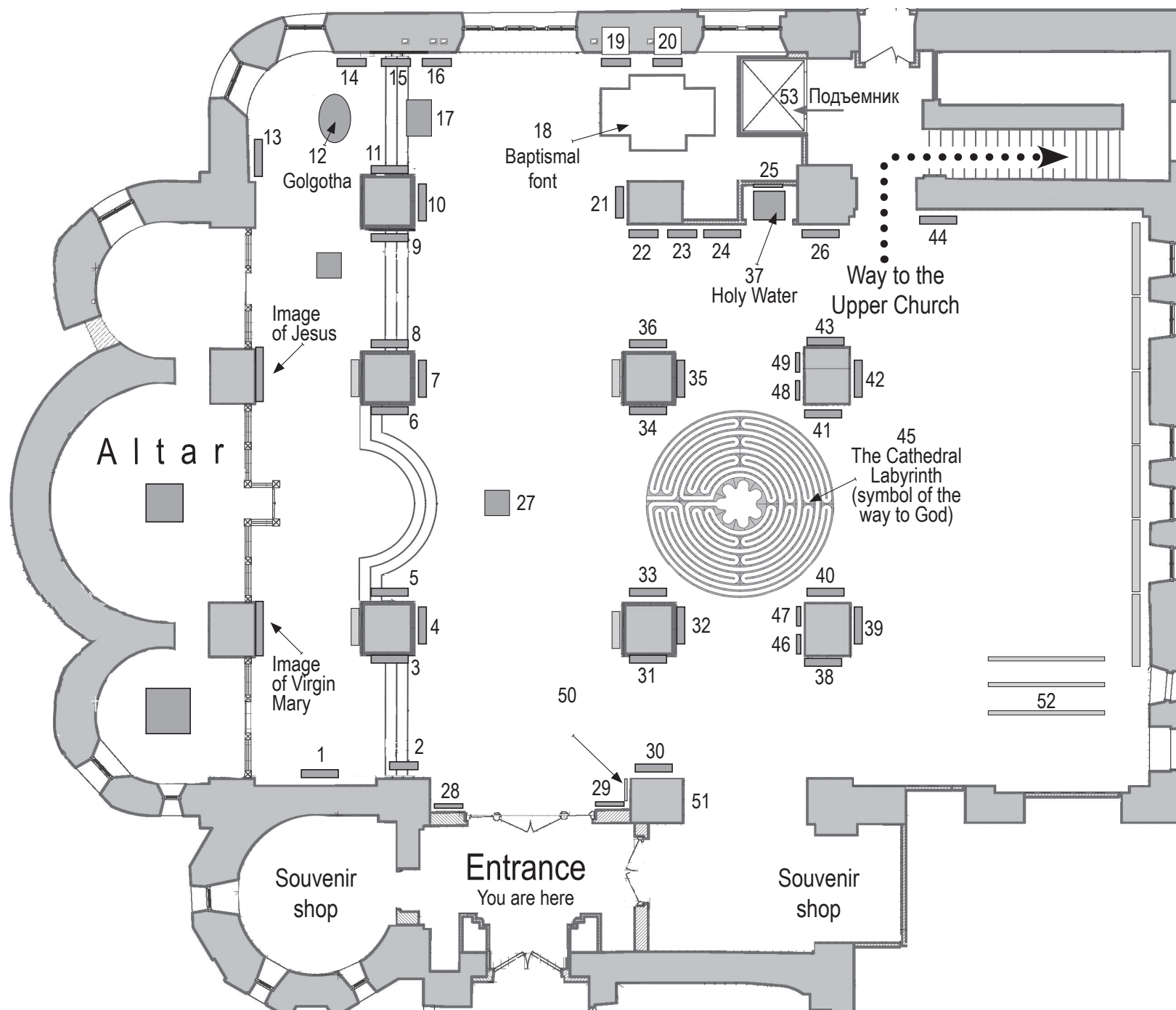
The Lower church of the Cathedral is dedicated to the Holy Right-Believing Prince Alexander Nevsky and the Holy Equal-to-Apostles Mary Magdalene, the heavenly patrons of Emperor Alexander III (1845–1894) and his wife, Empress Maria Feodorovna (1847–1928).

The reconstruction of the Lower church decoration was carried out in 2010–2013 according to the project of Archimandrite Zinon (Teodor), who created frescoes in the altar apses and a number of icons in the church (marked with \* in the table).

During the restoration of the cathedral, the desire expressed by the Construction Committee in 1917 to design the Lower Church in the style of early Christianity in Russia, similar to the Byzantine churches of 1000 years ago, was taken into account. Instead of an iconostasis, a low stone partition wall separating the altar space is used here. Three altar apses have found their ancient functional purpose. In the centre there is a Holy Table, in the northern apse there is a Prothesis with a Table of Oblation for Proskomedie, and in the southern one there is a diaconicon.
